In order to be in compliance with article 82 of Law 24/1988, the Spanish Securities Market Act, Abengoa, S.A. (the "Company") herewith informs the Spanish Securities Market Commission of the following:

Relevant Fact

1.- On this date the Board of Directors of Abengoa, S.A., at the suggestion of the Spanish Appointments and Remunerations Commission, has agreed to appoint Mr Ricardo Martínez Rico as a board member for a term of four years using the co-option procedure.

Mr Ricardo Martínez Rico is joining the Board of Directors as an independent board member. This appointment shall be put before the company's next General Shareholders' Meeting for ratification.

Mr Ricardo Martínez Rico has a Business Sciences Degree and was awarded an extraordinary prize upon graduation, is a Technical Trade Specialist, State Economist and founder partner and CEO of Equipo Económico, S.L.
