

Opening of the walkway at Abengoa's Campus Palmas Altas

- The walkway, which is 80 meters long, connects Campus Palmas Altas with the Seville neighborhood of Los Bermejales.
- The project encourages good relations between pedestrians and cyclists, while also promoting sustainable mobility.

Seville, February 14 2011. The pedestrian and cyclists' walkway that connects Campus de Palmas Altas, Abengoa's headquarters in Seville, with the Los Bermejales neighborhood, will be opened tomorrow Wednesday 15 February. The new walkway will make employees' journeys to the work center and into the city safer, more convenient and more sustainable.

The walkway, which like the company's headquarters has been designed by the prestigious architect Richard Rogers and the Spanish architecture firm Vidal y Asociados Arquitectos, consists of a large bridge that is 80 meters long and 3.20 meters wide over the SE-30 highway. The project combines high quality materials with an innovative design and is enclosed and protected by a steel wire mesh.

The walkway will enable pedestrians to safely cross the SE-30, while also encouraging good relations between pedestrians and cyclists, helping to promote sustainable mobility. It has also been specifically designed for people with reduced mobility.

This project will especially benefit the more than 2,500 people that work in Campus Palmas Altas every day, although it is open to all residents of Seville since the walkway has been gifted by Abengoa to the municipality.
