Abengoa awarded hospital expansion project in Uruguay

• The contract is valued at 6.5 M USD.

April 12, 2016 - Abengoa (MCE: ABG.B / P SM / NASDAQ: ABGB), an international company that applies innovative technology solutions for sustainable development in the energy and environment sectors, has been selected to carry out the execution of the second phase of Sector 5 of the Central Hospital of the Armed Forces of Montevideo, Uruguay. The contract is worth 6.5 MUSD and is expected to last 18 months.

Abengoa will be responsible for the full implementation of the new building. The project involves the demolition of an existing building, the executive project, the foundations of the new building, the construction of the reinforced concrete structure and the finishing of installations. This second phase also includes the development of general and trauma rooms and an intermediate intensive treatment center. The company will be responsible for running all sanitary, electrical, thermal plants, medicinal fluids, and firefighting.

The new building will have similar features to that developed by Abengoa in the first phase: a building of 3,800 m² with 54 double rooms with private bathrooms, seven clinics, seven nursing homes and a center of cardiological intensive treatment, plus all associated facilities.

This new project consolidates the leadership and expertise of Abengoa in implementing hospital works. In Uruguay alone, where the company is present for 35 years, Abengoa has been responsible for projects Hospital of the Spanish Association and the American Hospital, in addition to the expansion of Sanatorium John Paul II. Similarly, it has carried out numerous projects of civil, electrical, hydraulic and industrial work throughout the country.
