Abengoa to supply structures for new transmission line in Lithuania

• The company thereby contributes to the country's best electricity interconnection with neighboring Poland.

May 22, de 2017 – Abengoa (MCE: ABG/P:SM), the international company that applies innovative technology solutions for sustainability in the energy and environment sectors, has been selected by Zilinskis ir Co; the infrastructure solutions company, to supply the required structures for the construction of a new 330kV transmission line, 53 km in length which will interconnect Alytus and Kruonis, two cities located in southern Lithuania. The project is worth 23 M€.

Abengoa will be responsible for the supply of approximately 3,700 tons of steel which is required to make the structures for the 330kV electricity line that will run from Alytus to Kruonis, and will interconnect the Kruonis hydroelectric power station, located in the Kaunas region, to the Alytus substation which is located in the province with the same name.

This will be the second 330kV electricity line built in the country since its independence in 1990, and will play a decisive role in the interconnection between Lithuania and Poland. In addition, it will help to ensure a more secure electricity supply in the south of the country and respond to the growing demand for energy in this area.

Abengoa has extensive experience in supplying structures for projects of all kinds worldwide. In the area of transmission and distribution alone, the company has been involved in supplying structures for over 27,000 km of transmission lines and distribution and more than 330 substations constructed in the last 15 years.
