- The company made the presentation "Commercial thermal energy storage systems in CSP plants: steam vs molten salts".

April 16, 2018 - Abengoa (MCE: ABG/P:SM), the international company that applies innovative technology solutions for sustainability in the infrastructures, energy and water sectors, participated in the XIV edition of the International Congress of Energy and Mineral Resources, which took place in Seville between April 10 and 13.

Under the motto "Sustaining the future", the objective of this meeting was "to establish a framework for debate where all the people and entities related to the different fields of activity in which the mining engineers is present look for sustainable solutions for the current technological challenges", as pointed out by Ángel Cámara Rascón, president of the National Association of Mining Engineers and dean president of the Higher Council of Mining Engineers' Associations.
